23. Operating ATV on cropland or pastureland. A person is guilty-of-operating-an-ATV-on-crop-land-or-pastureland,-if-he
eperates may not operate an ATV on any-crop-land cropland or pastureland without the permission of the owner or lessee. As used in this subsection, erep-land "cropland" means acreage in tillage rotation, land being cropped and land in bush fruits.
"Pastureland" means acreage devoted to the production of forage plants used for animal production.

<u>A person who violates this subsection commits a Class E crime.</u>

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Sec. 9. 12 MRSA §7859, first ¶, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 762. 2 §23, is amended to read:

When a law enforcement officer issues a summons for a violation under this subchapter, the officer may impound the ATV
operated by the person who received the summons if, in the judgment of the officer, based on actual previous offenses by the
operator or other considerations, the operator will continue to operate the vehicle in violation and such operation may be a
hazard to the safety of persons or property. <u>A law enforcement officer may impound an ATV used in violation of section 7857</u>,
subsections 1 to 5 or 23 based solely on that violation.
