COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 652, L.D. 875, Bill, "An Act To Promote and Advance Wild Ring-necked Pheasant Propagation"

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of paragraph C (page 1, lines 20 to 21 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'C. A person may not take a female pheasant in an area subject to the provisions of section 7472. A person who violates this paragraph commits a Class E crime.'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 1, lines 35 and 36 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "section 1 by creating a spring hunting season and" and inserting in its place the following: 'the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 7472 by creating' and in the 5th line (page 1, line 37 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "disallow" and inserting in its place the following: 'disallows'

SUMMARY

This amendment removes language from the bill that authorizes a spring pheasant hunt and clarifies that a person who takes a female pheasant commits a Class E crime.
