This amendment clarifies that a Social Security benefit is included among the category of pensions that are not offset against unemployment compensation benefits. It also makes a technical correction by deleting unnecessary language from the bill and revises a provision of the bill for greater clarity.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The Department of Labor estimates this bill will increase benefits paid from the Unemployment Compensation Trust Fund beginning in fiscal year 2003-04. The amount can not be determined at this time. However, estimates developed by the Department of Labor using 2002 data indicate the increase in benefit costs to be approximately \$2,700,000. The cost increase would move the unemployment contributions schedule from B to C for rate year 2005, increasing collections by \$12,200,000 in 2005 and an additional \$1,500,000 in 2006. The State and all other direct reimbursement employers will be required to repay the Unemployment Compensation Trust Fund for the additional benefit payments.
