SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 286, L.D. 891, Bill, "An Act To Require the Videotaping of Police Interrogations"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "PUBLIC SAFETY, DEPARTMENT OF" by striking out all of the 2nd to 5th lines (page 3, lines 23 to 27 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:


'State Mandate - Audio Taping of Interrogations

Initiative: Appropriates funds to be distributed to local law enforcement agencies for the purpose of complying with a state mandate regarding the audio taping of certain interrogations. Funds appropriated for this purpose may not lapse but must be carried forward in succeeding fiscal years.'
