Current law prohibits unlawful discrimination in the sale, rental, lease or management of housing accommodation. The term "housing accommodation" does not currently include the rental of a one-family unit if one unit is owner-occupied or the rental of 4 or fewer rooms of a one-family dwelling that is owner-occupied. This bill eliminates those exclusions.

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
