Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1351, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

6 4. Requirements. A driver education course approved under  
8 this subchapter must include instruction that imparts the  
10 understanding and skills necessary to operate a motor vehicle  
12 safely in a situation in which a motorcycle is sharing the road  
14 with that motor vehicle.
