Sec. 1. State Board of Funeral Services and State Registrar of Vital Statistics to establish system for electronic filing of death certificates. Resolved: That the State Board of Funeral Services and the State Registrar of Vital Statistics jointly shall establish a system for electronic filing of death certificates with municipal clerks and with the State. The State Registrar of Vital Statistics may adopt rules to carry out the purpose of this resolve. Rules adopted pursuant to this resolve are major substantive rules pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.

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## SUMMARY

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This resolve directs the State Board of Funeral Services and the State Registrar of Vital Statistics jointly to establish a system for electronic filing of death certificates with municipal clerks and with the State.
