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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " \mathcal{H} " to H.P. 675, L.D. 918

SUMMARY

This amendment designates the Department of Tourism, Economic and Community Development as the lead agency for 4 providing information and business assistance to employers and businesses in response to an event that triggers rapid-response б activities. The bill would have designated that department as the lead agency for the entire State response to such an event. 8 The amendment retains for the Department of Labor its current role as the lead agency for providing assistance to workers 10 affected by such an event and directs the Department of Labor, 12 within 90 days from the effective date of the Act, to develop a directory of organizations that can provide resources to laid-off 14 workers.
