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This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

bill proposes to require the Department 10 Environmental Protection and the Executive Department, State Planning Office to prepare statements pertaining to the impact that proposed legislation, agency rules or agency action 12 concerning each respective agency has upon municipalities, private ownership, property rights or agency resources, including 14 the costs that the agency would bear. The statements would be furnished to the appropriate joint standing committee of the 16 Legislature for the information of its members and for inclusion in bills that receive an "ought to pass" report when reported by 18 the committee. A statement would not be required for legislation

that has no impact upon the respective agency.
