2	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 4	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7451, sub-§1, ¶C, as amended by PL 1989, c. 493, §29, is further amended to read:
б	C. There shall-be is an open season on using a dog or dogs
8	in conjunction with bear hunting from the first Monday preceding September 1st, to the <u>last</u> day preceding-the-open
10	firearm-season-on-deer-provided-in-section-7457,-subsection 1 of September.
12	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7451, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1997, c. 432, §42, is further amended to read:
14 16	3. Placing of bear bait. Placing of bear bait shall must be in conformity with the following provisions.
18	A. Bait may not be used to hunt or trap black bear, unless:
20	(1) The bait is placed at least 50 yards from any travel way that is accessible by a conventional 2-wheel
22	or 4-wheel drive vehicle;
24	(2) The stand, blind or bait area is plainly labeled with a 2-inch by 4-inch tag with the name and address
26	of the baiter;
28	(3) The bait is placed more than 500 yards from any dump or campground;
30	(4) The bait is placed more than 500 yards from an
32	occupied dwelling, unless written permission is granted by the owner or leasee;
34	(5) The bait is placed not mere-than-30-days before
36	the-opening day-of the season <u>October 1st</u> and not after October 31st;

40	(6) The bait areas will be cleaned up by November 10th, as defined by the state litter laws; and
42	(7) The person hunting from any stand or blind of another person has permission of the owner of that
44	stand or blind.
46	SUMMARY
48	This bill separates the season for placing bait for bear
50	from the season for hunting bear with dogs.
