COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 698, L.D. 941, Bill, "An Act To Strengthen the Criminal Laws by Expanding the Definition of Trafficking and Furnishing Prescription Narcotic Drugs To Include Illegal Possession of a Large Number of Pills"

Amend the bill in section 3 in paragraph F in the first line (page 1, line 18 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "To" the following: 'unlawfully'

Further amend the bill in section 6 in paragraph D in the first line (page 1, line 38 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "To" the following: 'unlawfully'
