

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 701, L.D. 944, Bill, "An Act To Increase Penalties for Furnishing or Trafficking Scheduled Drugs That Cause Death or Serious Bodily Injury"

Amend the amendment in section 7 in paragraph K in the 8th line (page 2, line 4 in amendment) by striking out the following: "serious bodily injury" and inserting in its place the following: 'death'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment is being offered on behalf of the Committee on Engrossed Bills. It changes the provision regarding an affirmative defense for a defendant who believed that death was not reasonably foreseeable from the use of a lawfully possessed scheduled drug that was unlawfully furnished in order to be consistent with the legislative intent.
