2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA c. 220, sub-c. 2, §1830** is enacted to read:

6 **§1830. Maine resident reservation period**

8 A system established to accept reservations for overnight
10 camping facilities at a state park, including a system
12 established under section 1827 or chapter 211, must hold the
14 first week that reservations are accepted for residents of the
16 State only.

18 **SUMMARY**

20 This bill requires that reservation systems for state parks
22 hold open the first week that reservations are accepted for
24 residents of the State only.
