Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 12 MRSA c. 220, sub-c. 2, §1830 is enacted to read:
§1830. Maine resident reservation period
A system established to accept reservations for overnight
camping facilities at a state park, including a system
established under section 1827 or chapter 211, must hold the
first week that reservations are accepted for residents of the
State only.
SUMMARY
This bill requires that reservation systems for state parks hold open the first week that reservations are accepted for
residents of the State only.
