24	subsection 10 and inserting in its place the following:
26	'10. Estimated benefit. Upon inquiry from an individual, the Department of Labor shall provide an estimate of the amount
28	and duration of benefits likely to be paid to that individual under this chapter if the individual applied for benefits that
30	day. If the inquiry is made within 2 weeks before the beginning of a calendar quarter, the Department of Labor shall also provide
32	an estimate of the duration and amount of benefits likely to be paid to that individual if the individual applied for benefits
34	after the beginning of that calendar quarter. Inquiries under this subsection may be made and answered over the telephone and
36	are not considered applications for benefits.'
38	SUMMARY

42	This amendment provides that the information given by the Department of Labor to a person who inquires about unemployment compensation benefits is an estimate, not an actual calculation
44	of benefits. It clarifies that an inquiry is not considered an
46	application for benefits. It also provides that the estimate is for benefits that would be paid if the individual applied on the
48	day of the inquiry. If the inquiry is made within 2 weeks before the beginning of a calendar quarter, the department must also
