2	Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §1194, sub-§13 is enacted to read:

	13. Voluntary withdrawal. A claimant who has filed a claim
6	for benefits under this section may voluntarily withdraw that
	claim at any time before receiving the benefits. The
8	commissioner shall treat a claimant who has withdrawn a claim
	under this subsection as not having filed the claim. A claimant
10	may withdraw a claim under this subsection by way of telephone.

	SUMMARY

	This bill allows a claimant for unemployment benefits to
16	withdraw the claim at any time before receiving benefits and by

telephone. This bill requires the Department of Labor to treat a

claimant who has withdrawn a claim as not having filed the claim.
