Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §1676-A is enacted to read:
§1676-A. Display prices of home heating oil required
1. Display required. A retailer of home heating oil shall
display the price per gallon on each truck that is delivering home heating oil for that retailer in a clear and conspicuous
manner.
2. Enforcement. A retailer who violates this section commits a civil violation for which a fine of not more than \$100
for the first offense and not more than \$500 for each subsequent offense may be adjudged.

SUMMARY
This bill requires that retailers of home heating oil
display the price per gallon on their delivery trucks.
