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CONCEPT DRAFT SUMMARY

8 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

10 The purpose of this bill is to consolidate the advocacies of the various state agencies into an executive department. The 12 executive department would assume any public advocacy responsibilities currently assigned to other agencies of State Government. The bill also would establish the Office of 14 Inspector General to investigate governmental abuse of funds, written policy and procedures and violation of the law within the 16 various state departments. The executive advocacy department would oversee the operations and personnel of the Office of the 18 Inspector General.
