- HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 310,
  L.D. 969, Bill, "An Act To Ensure Equity in Mortgage Volume Fees"
- 18 Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first indented paragraph after the title (page 1, lines 22 to 24 in 20 amendment) and inserting in its place the following:
- 22 'Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:
- 'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
   become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
- Whereas, the Committee to Study the Revenue Sources of the 30 Office of Consumer Credit Regulation is required to submit its report to the Legislature in December 2003; and

- Whereas, the committee must begin its meetings as soon as possible in order to complete its work by December; and
- 36 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 38 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 40 safety; now, therefore,
- 42 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: ' '

Further amend the amendment in section 3 by striking out all of subsection 6 (page 4, lines 20 to 28 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'6. Report. The committee shall submit its report to the б Second Regular Session of the 121st Legislature no later than December 3, 2003. The committee may submit a bill to the 8 Legislature to implement its recommendations at the time of submission of its report. If the committee requires a limited 10 extension of time to complete its report, it may apply to the Legislative Council, which may grant the extension.'

Further amend the amendment by inserting at the end the 14 following:

16 'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'

## SUMMARY

22 This amendment adds an emergency preamble and emergency clause, requires the Committee to Study the Revenue Sources of the Office of Consumer Credit Regulation to submit its report to 24 the Second Regular Session of the 121st Legislature no later than 26 December 3, 2003 and authorizes the committee to submit a bill to the Legislature at the time of submission of its report.
