COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 311, L.D. 970, Bill, "An Act To Allow a Judge To Assess a Fee on a Defendant To Reimburse a Municipality for a Drug Test"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§1702." in subsection 2 in paragraph B in the first line (page 1, line 18 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "pay" the following: ', as restitution,' and in the last line (page 1, line 23 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "municipality, county or agency" and inserting in its place the following: 'municipal, county or state agency'

SUMMARY

This amendment adds state agencies to those who may be reimbursed for the costs of administering drug tests and clarifies that the court may order costs paid as part of a defendant's restitution.
