Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. P&SL 1835, c. 556, §1, as amended by P&SL 1875, c. 11,
4 §2, is further amended to read:

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Sec. 1. Name of persons incorporated. That Robert Hallowell
8 Gardiner, Frederic Allen, Edward Swan, Phineas Pratt, Arthur
Berry, John Merrill, Patrick H. Greenleaf and Joseph T. Harris,
together with their associates and successors ~~be-and-they-hereby~~
10 are incorporated into a body politic by the name of the Maine
Episcopal Missionary Society with power to sue and be sued, to
12 have a common seal and to change the same; to make any by-laws
for the management of their affairs not repugnant to the laws of
14 this State; and to take hold and possess any real or personal
estate without limit as to the value of ~~one hundred thousand~~
16 ~~dollars~~ and to give and grant, bargain and sell or lease the same.

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SUMMARY

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This bill amends the charter of the Maine Episcopal
22 Missionary Society by removing the \$100,000 limit on the value of
real or personal estate held by the society.
