S	1407. Cancer prevention, research and treatment
	1. Program established. The Bureau of Health shall
<u>e</u>	stablish a cancer prevention and control program to provide
1	eadership for and coordination of cancer prevention, research
	nd treatment activities. The program may include, but is not
1	imited to:
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	A. Monitoring cancer prevalence at the state and community
	levels through the cancer-incidence registry under section
	1404 and other means:
	B. Education and training of health professionals on the
	current methods of diagnosing and treating cancer;
	C. Patient and family education on how to manage the
	disease and the treatment of the disease; and
	D. Consultation with and support of community-based cancer
	prevention, research and treatment programs.
	2. Consultation. In implementing the program established
;	n subsection 1, the Bureau of Health shall consult with the
	dedicaid program administered by the department and with the
	epartment of Education. In addition, the bureau shall seek
	dvice from other organizations and private entities concerned
	ith cancer prevention, research and treatment.
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	3. Funding. The Bureau of Health may accept federal funds
ç	nd grants for implementing the program established in subsection
1	and may contract for work with outside vendors or individuals.
