## An Act To Ensure Effective Prosecution of Certain Repeat Offenders

### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 17-A MRSA §1252, sub-§4-A, as amended by PL 2003, c. 1, §10, is further amended to read:

4-A. If the State pleads and proves that, at the time any 6 crime, excluding murder, under chapter 9, 11, 13 or 27 or section 402-A, subsection 1, paragraph A was committed, the defendant had 8 been convicted of 2 or more crimes violating chapter 9, 11, 13 or 27 or section 402-A, subsection 1, paragraph A or essentially 10 similar crimes in other jurisdictions, the sentencing class for the crime is one class higher than it would otherwise be. In the 12 case of a Class A crime, the sentencing class is not increased, 14 but the prior record must be given serious consideration by the court when imposing a sentence. Section 9-A governs the use of prior convictions when determining a sentence, except that, for 16 the purposes of this subsection, for violations under chapter 11, the dates of prior convictions may have occurred at any time. 18

#### **SUMMARY**

This bill amends the provision of the Maine Criminal Code that allows enhanced prosecution of persons for certain crimes 24 who have at least 2 previous convictions for certain offenses by 26 adding references to a crime that is not in chapter 9, 11, 13 or 27 of the Maine Criminal Code. Aggravated criminal trespass in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 17-A, section 402-A, subsection 28 1, paragraph A always includes within its proof the commission of 30 a crime in chapters 9 or 11 of the Maine Criminal Code, but aggravated criminal trespass is in chapter 17 and therefore 32 currently does not raise the sentencing category for certain This bill also adds aggravated criminal subsequent crimes. 34 trespass to the list of crimes for which enhanced prosecution may be sought in the case of a defendant who has prior convictions 36 for certain crimes.
