B. The warden, ward clerk or deputy warden shall write "Defective ballot" en-the-ballet and the reason that the ballot is defective on the ballot and shall sign it and-keep it-segregated from the other ballets. The election official shall then segregate the defective ballot with any other defective ballots in an envelope labeled "Defective ballots" and shall package and return the envelope of segregated ballots in accordance with section 698. The Secretary of State shall provide the clerk of each municipality with either a label and instructions on proper handling of defective ballots or a special envelope printed with this label and instructions.

Sec. 3. 21-A MRSA  $\S696$ , sub- $\S5$ ,  $\PB$ , as enacted by PL 2001, c. 310,  $\S42$ , is amended to read:

B. The warden, ward clerk or deputy warden shall write "Void ballot" en-the-ballet and the reason that the ballot is void on the ballot and shall keep-it-segregated-from-the ether-ballets sign it. The election official shall then segregate the void ballot with any other void ballots in an envelope labeled "Void ballots" and shall package and return the envelope of segregated ballots in accordance with section 698. The Secretary of State shall provide the clerk of each municipality with either a label and instructions on proper handling of void ballots or a special envelope printed with this label and instructions.'

#### **SUMMARY**

This amendment replaces the bill and requires that spoiled, defective and void ballots be segregated in labeled envelopes and packaged and returned according to the requirements for other ballots and voting materials. The Secretary of State shall provide each municipal clerk with either an instructional label for each type of segregated ballot envelope or a specially printed envelope containing the label and instructions.
