
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 326, L.D. 985, Bill, "An Act To Improve the State's Returnable Bottle Law and Adjust Handling Fees"

Amend the amendment on page 2 in subsection 4 in paragraph A in the 7th line (page 2, line 14 in amendment) by striking out the following: "3 1/2¢" and inserting in its place the following: '5 1/2¢'

Further amend the amendment on page 2 in subsection 4 in paragraph B in the 7th line (page 2, line 26 in amendment) by striking out the following: "3 1/2¢" and inserting in its place the following: '5 1/2¢'

SUMMARY

This amendment increases the handling fee that an initiator of a deposit must pay to a dealer or redemption center by 2¢ per returned container, beginning January 1, 2004.
