SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 326, L.D. 985, Bill, "An Act To Improve the State's Returnable Bottle Law and Adjust Handling Fees"

Amend the bill in section 4 in subsection 4 in paragraph A in the 5th line (page 2, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "5¢" and inserting in its place the following: '6 1/2¢'

Further amend the bill in section 4 in subsection 4 in paragraph B in the 5th line (page 2, line 15 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "5¢" and inserting in its place the following: '6 1/2¢'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment increases the handling fee that an initiator of a deposit must pay to a dealer or redemption center so that a dealer or redemption center receives at least a 2¢ per returned container increase in the handling fee.
