HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 330, L.D. 989, Bill, "An Act To Transfer Speech Pathologist Licensure Functions to the Department of Education"

Amend the amendment in section 10 in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 4, lines 38 and 39 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs" and inserting in its place the following: 'Second Regular Session of the 121st Legislature'

Further amend the amendment in section 10 in the 5th line (page 4, line 40 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "and" the following: 'to'

Further amend the amendment in section 10 in the 5th line (page 4, line 40 in amendment) by striking out the following: "January 15, 2004" and inserting in its place the following: 'December 3, 2003'

Further amend the amendment in section 10 in the 6th line (page 4, line 41 in amendment) by striking out the following: "receipt and"

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 11.

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

6 This amendment authorizes the task force to submit its
8 report to the Second Regular Session of the 121st Legislature
10 rather than to the Joint Standing Committee on Education and
12 Cultural Affairs. It changes the reporting date from January 15,
14 2004, to December 3, 2003. It also removes the provision
16 allowing the Legislative Council to grant an extension of time
18 for the task force to complete its study.
