4 **Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1255, sub-§7** is enacted to read:

6 **7. Person who performs work on certain vessels.** A person  
who performs work only on vessels under 200 feet long.

12 This bill exempts a person who performs work only on vessels  
under 200 feet long from the laws governing professional  
engineers.
