6	A. A registration expires <u>annually</u> on the last day of the
	<u>birth</u> month ene-year-from-the-month-of-issuance <u>of the owner</u>
8	of the vehicle. If more than one person's name appears on
	the title, the registration expires on the last day of the
10	<u>birth month of the first-listed owner of the vehicle</u>
	following registration. The initial registration must be
12	prorated if the period of time until the registration
	expires is less than 11 months. If the vehicle is not owned
14	by a person, then the provisions of subsection 2 apply.
16	Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §1751, sub-§5 is enacted to read:
18	5. Expiration. An inspection sticker issued pursuant to
	section 1758 expires at the same time as the vehicle's
