This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment exempts the installation of stand-alone water meters, water meters in combination with nontestable backflow prevention devices and related valves by water utility personnel or water utility contractors from municipal plumbing inspection and permitting requirements. The amendment also requires that a statement be included in any notice provided to a customer regarding entry to install such water meters or related valves that installation of a backflow preventor may necessitate installation by the customer of additional devices, such as an expansion tank, due to thermal expansion.
