	This bill proposes to alter current requirements for
10	recording on deeds the existence of burial plots.
12	This bill would allow a deed to reflect the presence of a
	burial lot on the subject property if the person recording the
14	deed has personal knowledge of the fact that a burial lot exists
	on the property, even if the person didn't personally bury the
16	body.
18	This bill would also exempt from property tax that portion
10	of the property on which the burial lot is located.
