8 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

10 This bill would impose a fee on nonresidents of the State
12 who participate in recreational amusement activities within the
14 State. Under the bill, "recreational amusement activities" would
include skiing, bowling, movies, plays, concerts, carnivals,
amusement parks and other entertainment activity for which a
business charges admission for exhibition, amusement or
recreation.
