Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:	
Sec.1. 12 MRSA §7773-A is enacted to read:	
§7773-A. Sport fish restoration	
1. Fishing survey. The department, in cooperation with t	he
Department of Marine Resources, shall annually conduct a surv	
to determine the total number of people engaged in recreation	
fishing in the inland waters and the total number of peop	le
engaged in recreational fishing in the coastal waters.	
2. Federal funds allocation. Using information receiv	<u>ed</u>
under subsection 1, the department shall proportionate	
distribute any funds received from the Federal Aid in Sport Fi	
Restoration funds, 50 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 80.2	3,
between saltwater and freshwater fisheries projects.	
3. Report. The department, in cooperation with t	
Department of Marine Resources, shall annually by December 31s	
<u>submit a report to the joint standing committee of t</u> Legislature having jurisdiction over inland fisheries a	
wildlife matters and the joint standing committee of t	
Legislature having jurisdiction over marine resources matters	
the result of the survey under subsection 1 and on t	
distribution of funds under subsection 2.	
4. Repeal. This section is repealed January 1, 2009.	
SUMMARY	
This bill requires the Department of Inland Fisheries a	
Wildlife, in cooperation with the Department of Marine Resource	
to conduct an annual survey of people fishing in the inland a	
coastal waters of the State and to use the survey results equitably distribute federal funds between saltwater a	to and

report on the results of the survey and the distribution of t	
federal grant funds be presented annually to the Joint Standi	
Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife and the Joint Standi
