way for the public to file a complaint with the agency, a procedure for the agency to address complaints from the public and a provision that requires the agency to notify a complainant of the outcome of the complaint. This subsection does not authorize the release of confidential information that may not otherwise be released to the public.'

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## **SUMMARY**

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This amendment replaces the bill. Whereas the bill would establish a liaison for public complaints for all state employees, the amendment ensures that each state agency establishes a policy that makes certain that complaints by the public against state employees are addressed by that agency. The amendment prohibits the release of confidential information that may not otherwise be released to the public.
