COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 766, L.D. 1049, Bill, "An Act To Allow Women Recovering from Childbirth To Be Issued Temporary Handicapped Parking Permits"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act to Allow Certain Women Recovering from Childbirth To Be Issued Temporary Handicapped Parking Permits'**

Further amend the bill in section 4 in paragraph A by striking out all of subparagraphs (1) to (3) (page 1, lines 38 to 43 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:

'(1) One week after cesarean section delivery; or

(2) A time to be determined by the patient's physician after the birth of a preterm infant.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 5 (page 1, lines 45 to 50 in L.D.)

**SUMMARY**

This is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation. The amendment imposes limitations on the issuance of temporary disability placards to women recovering from childbirth. The amendment requires temporary placards to be issued for a period of one week after cesarean section delivery and for a time determined by the patient's physician for a preterm infant.
