Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7352-A, sub-§4**, as amended by PL 2001, c.
387, §14, is repealed.

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Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7352-A, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

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10 5. Requirements. Each licensee shall ensure that each deer
hide is properly tagged pursuant to section 7457.

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SUMMARY

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16 This bill reduces the paperwork requirement under a special
hide dealer's license by requiring only that the dealer ensure
that a deer hide is properly tagged.
