COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 781, L.D. 1063, Bill, "An Act Concerning Municipal Firearms Discharge Ordinances"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 5 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "throughout" and inserting in its place the following: 'during'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 5 in the 7th line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "boundaries" the following: 'as points of reference'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 5 in the 8th line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "includes" the following: 'but is not limited to'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 5 in the 9th to 13th lines (page 1, lines 14 to 18 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "A municipality that adopts a firearm discharge ordinance shall prepare a wildlife management plan to prevent overpopulation of game animals in the area in which the discharge of firearms is prohibited by the firearm discharge ordinance."
