HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 783, L.D. 1065, "Resolve, Directing the Commissioner of Public Safety To Study the Emergency Medical Services System"

Amend the amendment in section 3 in the last line (page 2, line 16 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "this resolve" the following: '. In no instance may the commissioner expend General Fund appropriations to carry out the purposes of this resolve'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 5 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 5. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved: That the following appropriations and allocations are made.

Initiative: Allocates funds on a one-time basis for the costs of conducting an independent study of the statewide emergency medical services system.
