48	This bill amends the Probate Code to increase the fees allowed a register of probate for receiving and entering a

- petition or application for estates. The fees are based on the value of the estate. Currently, the fees top out at \$750 for estates valued at more than \$2,000,000. This bill increases the
- fees in \$50 increments for each additional \$500,000 of value of an estate, to a maximum fee of \$1,550 for an estate valued at
- 6 more than \$10,000,000.
