The appointing authorities shall notify the Executive Director of the Legislative Council once all appointments have been completed. Within 15 days after appointment of all members, the executive director shall call and convene the first meeting of the committee; and be it further

- Sec. 6. Staff assistance. Resolved: That, upon approval of the Legislative Council, the Office of Policy and Legal Analysis shall provide necessary staffing services to the committee; and be it further
- Sec. 7. Compensation. Resolved: That legislative members of 10 the committee are entitled to the legislative per diem, as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 2, and 12 reimbursement for travel and other necessary expenses related to their attendance at authorized meetings of the committee. Public 14 members not otherwise compensated by their employers or other represent entitled 16 entities that they are reimbursement of necessary expenses and, upon a demonstration of financial hardship, a per diem equal to the legislative per diem 18 for their attendance at authorized meetings of the committee; and 20 be it further
- Sec. 8. Report. Resolved: 22 That, no later than January 15, 2004, the committee shall submit a report that includes its 24 findings and recommendations, including suggested legislation, for presentation to the Second Regular Session of the 121st 26 Legislature. The committee is authorized to introduce legislation related to its report to the Second Regular Session 28 of the 121st Legislature at the time of submission of its report; and be it further

Sec. 9. Extension. Resolved: That, if the committee requires a limited extension of time to complete its study and make its report, it may apply to the Legislative Council, which may grant an extension; and be it further

Sec. 10. Committee budget. Resolved: That the chairs of the 36 committee, with assistance from the committee staff, shall administer the committee's budget. Within 10 days after its 38 first meeting, the committee shall present a work plan 40 proposed budget to the Legislative Council for its approval. committee may not incur expenses that would result in the 42 committee's exceeding its approved budget. Upon request from the committee, the Executive Director of the Legislative Council 44 shall promptly provide the committee chairs and staff with a status report on the committee budget, expenditures incurred and paid and available funds. 46
