COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "/ to H.P. 808, L.D. 1105

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Sec. 3. Chairs; convening of advisory work group. Resolved: That the departments shall jointly appoint cochairs of the advisory work group. When the appointment of all advisory work group members is complete, the cochairs of the advisory work group shall call and convene the first meeting of the advisory work group; and be it further

8 Sec. 4. Recommendations and report. Resolved: That the advisory work group shall make recommendations to the departments by 10 November 14, 2003 regarding fire safety issues in Head Start preschool programs located in public schools. The advisory work 12 group shall report the results of its work to the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services by January 30, 2004.'

#### **SUMMARY**

18 This amendment replaces the bill with a resolve. The amendment deletes the provisions amending the definition of "child care center" and the provisions amending the fire safety rules for Head Start preschool programs and replaces them with a requirement that the Department of Human Services and the Department of Education convene an advisory work group to examine fire safety issues in Head Start preschool programs located in public schools.
