**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

**Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §1874**, as enacted by PL 1997, c. 678, §13, is amended by adding after the first paragraph a new paragraph to read:

The person responsible for day-to-day management of the waterway must have received at the time of appointment, or must receive within 6 months of appointment to the position, 80 hours of training in the management of wilderness areas.
