COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 812, L.D. 1109

A. Certificate of registration solely for record-keeping purposes; or

B. Driver's license when the license is presented to a merchant who accepts payment by check or draft. The merchant shall keep the photocopy in a secure nonpublic location and shall destroy the photocopy once the check or draft has been honored. A merchant who violates this paragraph commits a Class D crime.'

SUMMARY

14 This amendment replaces the bill and is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice and Public 16 Safety.

18 This amendment allows a merchant to make a black-and-white photocopy of a driver's license when the merchant accepts payment 20 by check or draft. The merchant shall file the photocopy in a secure, nonpublic location and shall destroy the photocopy once 22 the check or draft has been paid.
