2.0	This bill requires each board of visitors for each of the 7
30	universities in the University of Maine System to submit an annual report of its activities to the Board of Trustees of the
32	University of Maine System. The Board of Trustees is required to submit a copy of the annual report of each board of visitors to
34	the Legislature and to the joint standing committee of the

Legislature having jurisdiction over education matters.
