Licensed master social worker. As a licensed master social 'worker, an applicant shall must have received either a masters or doctoral degree in social work or social welfare from an accredited educational institution or an institution in candidacy for accreditation from the Council on Social Work Education or a successor organization, shall must demonstrated to the satisfaction of the board adherence to the ethics of the social work profession and shall must have successfully completed the examination prescribed by the board. After meeting these qualifications, the applicant shall must receive a "licensed master social worker" license. In addition, any person wishing to practice social work in a clinical setting shall <u>must</u> receive a "licensed master social worker, conditional" license.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'

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#### **SUMMARY**

This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment allows master social worker licensure of a graduate of a social work or social welfare program of an institution in candidacy for accreditation from the Council on Social Work Education or a successor organization. The amendment also adds an emergency preamble and an emergency clause.
