COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 374, L.D. 1150, Bill, "An Act To Protect the Rights of State Workers"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§7053-A.~~" in subsection 2 in the first line (page 1, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the following: 'by July 1, 2004'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§7053-A.~~" in subsection 2 by striking out all the 2nd sentence (page 1, lines 16 to 18 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 'Rules adopted pursuant to this section are major substantive rules as defined in chapter 375, subchapter 2-A and must be provisionally adopted by February 15, 2005.'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§7053-A.~~" by inserting after subsection 2 the following:

'3. Application. This section applies only to persons who contract directly with the State and whose incomes from such service are reported to them by the State on United States Internal Revenue Service Form 1099.'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes a General Fund appropriation to the Department of Administrative and Financial Services in the amount of \$1,816,672 in fiscal year 2004-05 to fund 3 Senior Staff Accountants, software and data processing expenses and the extension of benefits to workers who contract directly with the state. This estimate assumes the benefits will begin to be paid for contracts in place during the last quarter of fiscal 2004-05.
