An Act To Exempt Saltwater-only Boats from the Lake and River Protection Sticker Requirements

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7794-B, first ¶, as amended by PL 2001, c.
4	626, $\$1$ and affected by $\$22$, is further amended to read:
6	Beginning on January 1, 2002, and by January 1st of each subsequent year, the commissioner shall provide each agent
8	authorized to register watercraft or issue licenses with a sufficient quantity of lake and river protection stickers for
10	that boating season. The sticker must be in 2 parts so that one part of the sticker can be affixed to each side of the bow of a
12	motorboat or personal watercraft. The fee for a sticker is \$20 for a motorboat or personal watercraft not registered in the
14	State and \$10 for a motorboat or personal watercraft registered in the State. Each agent shall retain \$1 for each sticker sold
16	by that agent for which a fee is required. A motorboat or a personal watercraft owned by the federal government, a state
18	government or a municipality <u>or used only in salt water</u> is exempt from the fee established in this section.

24 This bill exempts a motorboat or personal watercraft used only in salt water from the requirement for a lake and river 26 protection sticker.
