Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife is directed to  
4           amend the rules of the deer hunting season for the archery season  
and the muzzle-loading season so that the northern wildlife  
6           management districts may allow a 2-deer permit to hunt deer  
during the week before deer hunting season.
