HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 390, L.D. 1186, Bill, "An Act to Revise the Reimbursement by the County Jail Prisoner Support and Community Corrections Fund and To Provide Additional Support to County Jails"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of the first 2 lines (page 1, lines 3 and 4 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:

'Sec. 1. 34-A MRSA §1210-A, as amended by PL 2003, c. 20, Pt. R, §9, is further amended to read:'

Further amend the amendment in the first paragraph after the title in the first line (page 1, line 20 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following: 'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment on the 2nd page by striking out all of subsection 9 (page 2, lines 7 to 27 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'9. Surcharge imposed. In addition to the 14% surcharge collected pursuant to Title 4, section 1057, an additional 1% surcharge must be added to every fine, forfeiture or penalty imposed by any court in this State, which for the purposes of collection and collection procedures is considered a part of the fine, forfeiture or penalty. Except as provided in subsection 10, all funds collected pursuant to this subsection are nonlapsing and must be deposited monthly in the County Jail
