HOUSE AMENDMENT "**B**" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 908, L.D. 1234, "An Act To Protect Moderate-value and High-value Bird Habitats"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in the 5th line (page 1, line 36 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "rulemaking." the following: 'Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the rules adopted by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to define, identify and map high and moderate value waterfowl and wading bird habitats are routine technical rules.
